

Lumbar Stenosis

Presentation: Unilat or Bilat, L.E. Neuro Sx's, L.E. Claudication Pattern, Not LBP alone



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Comments:

- 1. P.T./OMT not regular part of stenosis algorithm unless you are just treating a mechanical LBP component in neuro-intact patient.
- 2. Most stenosis patients will be presenting with chronic SX's, not acute.
- 3. Anatomic lumbar stenosis may be global canal or subarticular. Isolated "Foraminal" stenosis produces radiculopathy.



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
